Generator

Information sheet for Standby Generator:

- Is permitted, subject to the following restrictions:
 - A side and rear setback of eight (15) feet must be maintained.
 - Must meet or exceed manufacturer's recommendations on clearances.
 - Prior approval by the utility company. Both natural gas inventory and stand-by generator commitment letter sheets need to be turned into and returned from them.
 - A final electrical inspection will need to be done.
 - Per the NYS Residential code a sign shall be located at the main panel box of the property that indicates the type and location of an on site emergency generator.

- A building permit is required for all standby generators. To obtain a permit the following must be turned into the Town Office:
 - A building permit application, this may be picked up at the office or downloaded from the town website (www.kendallny.org).
 - A map of the property is required to indicate the proposed location.
 - Information on the generator, make and model, clearances required from any buildings, windows, etc., wattage, who is going to install it.
 - Workman's Compensation/Disability insurance forms for any contractor working at the location.
 - A \$20 permit fee is payable to the Town of Kendall when the paperwork is dropped off. Your permit and any necessary paperwork can be mailed to you when completed.

- An electrical inspection by a third party inspector must be done prior to scheduling a final inspection.
- A final inspection is required upon completion of the generator and will be done by the Town of Kendall Building Department. (Please call 659-2341 at least 24 hours in advance to schedule)
