SUPERVISOR'S COMMENTS

Supervisor Cammarata said he decided to reinstate the resolution which was rescinded at the special meeting held on March 30, 2021. The original resolution will be restated, accepting Judge Gaudio's resignation. The chief administrative judges for our district have said the resignation cannot be rescinded, and an elected official cannot be granted a leave of absence, as an elected official does not answer to other than his/her constituency, and no office has jurisdiction to mandate the hours of an elected official. Judge Gaudio does not feel he should remain if he cannot fulfill the role properly.

RESOLUTIONS

RESOLUTION 55-0421 ACCEPTING THE HONORABLE DAVID GAUDIOSO'S RESIGNATION AS TOWN JUSTICE

WHEREAS, Judge Gaudio has tendered his resignation to the Town Clerk and to the Chief Administrative Judge of the NYS Unified Court System, effective as of April 5, 2021, so now the Kendall Town Board hereby

RESOLVES, to thank Judge Gaudio for his exceptional service to the community at large, and does, with regret, accept his resignation, and wish him well in his future endeavors.
