Community Choice Aggregation Public Hearing June 21, 2022 7:00 P.M. Kendall Town Hall

The Kendall Town Board is looking for public input regarding adopting a Community Choice Aggregation Program as Local Law #2 of 2022.

This initiative would permit the board to pool the collective bargaining power of residents, whom choose to participate, to negotiate lower electricity rates from renewable energy suppliers.

There are no costs associated for the residents or the Town. National Grid will continue to be the managing agent and residents can choose to opt in or opt out at any time without penalty.
